March 16, 2020 Update

Student Breakfast / Lunch:

Per the recent school closures due to the Coronavirus (COVID-19), free school breakfast and lunch will be made available to all students of the Wyomissing Area School District, starting Tuesday, March 17, 2020. Meals will be made available Monday through Friday during school closures (no meals on weekends).

Grab and Go meals will be offered at each school between 11 am and 12:30 pm. Only the student can pick up the meals which consist of one bagged lunch and breakfast, for the next day.

Meals can be picked up at the following locations between 11 am and 12:30 pm:

Junior Senior High School – Main entrance by the flag pole (Cambridge Ave. entrance) West Reading Elementary Center – Main entrance (S. 4th Ave) Wyomissing Hills Elementary Center – Main entrance (bus drop off area)
