



## JSHS Wyoming Area Virtual Education (WAVE) Frequently Asked Questions:

### Schedule for the First Week of School:

#### **Monday 8/31 (modified schedule) and Tuesday 9/1:**

- All WAVE students will log into their synchronous classes via Webex (links for classroom access will be posted on Schoology for each class) according to the attached schedule.

#### **Wednesday 9/2:**

- All students will have synchronous check-ins with all of their teachers, regardless of attendance group, according to the schedule provided (*period 1 begins at 11:30 a.m.*). Links to these check-ins will be on each teacher's Schoology page.

#### **Thursday 9/3 (modified schedule):**

- All WAVE and Hybrid B students will log into Schoology for their class announcements and/or assignments, but will not be attending class live via Webex.

#### **Friday 9/4: No School.**

### Virtual Attendance:

- Attendance will be taken for students who are scheduled to be working remotely through virtual instruction within Schoology. Each day students will need to log in to each of their courses, including homeroom, and complete the brief attendance form located within the Schoology course.
- Any students who do not complete the attendance form for a particular class will be marked virtually absent. Again, this is to be done for each course of the day, including homeroom, daily, when students are not physically in the building.
- Students **will not** be logging attendance for a scheduled study hall period.
- If your child is not able to log in to his/her virtual classes for the day due to an illness, please email Mrs. Beatrice Jones in the attendance office at [bjones@wyoarea.org](mailto:bjones@wyoarea.org) to report this absence, just as you would send in an absent excuse for a normal absence, during a normal school year.
