WASD Math Action Plan Progress - Focus #4 Intervention Supports

WHEC:

- Students are initially identified through benchmark assessments. Additional assessments are administered to determine specific deficits.
- Math Intervention Teacher works with Tier 2 and Tier 3 students (Pulled during math instruction)
 - Tier 2 20 minutes per group; 3 sessions/cycle
 - Tier 3 20 minutes per group; 6 sessions/cycle
- Progress monitoring occurs bi-weekly using assessments within the programs
- Instruction is based on skill gaps, not grade level content

WASD Team (Mr. Scoboria, Dr. Woodard and Dr. Jones)
met with representatives from Devopar Consulting to
discuss the scope of a potential master scheduling project.

 Devopar Consulting - Team is comprised of educational professionals with strong ties to Berks County. They possess expertise in both operational and curricular areas of school districts.

- Devopar presented a proposal consisting of a work plan divided into three Phases and associated deliverables
 - Phase 1: Data Collection and Research
 - Scope would include the following:
 - Interviews with key administrators and personnel
 - Walkthrough of facilities
 - Meetings with stakeholder focus groups
 - Creation of a data presentation and written report that includes aggregate data of findings.
 - Timeline: Spring Early Summer 2024

Cost for Phase 1: Not to Exceed \$16,991.48

- Devopar presented a proposal consisting of a work plan divided into three Phases and associated deliverables
 - Phase 2: Plan Development
 - Scope would include the following:
 - Develop 2-3 options for the reorganization of the master schedule for the JSHS
 - A written report will be created and presented
 - Timeline: Summer through mid-Fall 2024

Cost for Phase 2: To Be Determined

- Devopar presented a proposal consisting of a work plan divided into three Phases and associated deliverables
 - Phase 3: Implementation (If necessary)
 - Scope would include the following:
 - Once decision has been made by WASD,
 Devopar will provide support and technical assistance during the implementation phase of the plan
 - Timeline: Late Fall 2024 Summer 2025
