She thanked Greg Portner, Larry Fitzgerald and Angel Helm for their representation in the matter and commended the Association for moving the impasse to a hearing before the Pennsylvania Labor Relations Board's Fact Finder. She said the Board unanimously supports the recommendations and finding in the report.
